No right of discount, damages and/or any other remedies shall be available to the Purchaser with respect to defects of whatever kind or disappointed expectations of the Purchaser and/or receiving third parties. As the lots could be visited before or during the Auction and the Online Conditions were known, the Buyer is supposed to have examined carefully the lots he bought, and being informed about the state of the lots.”
